Equipment List:

Raingear

- waterproof jacket and pants of the best quality possible (we do have some gear to lend out!)
- waterproof hat and /or toque

High rubber boots

- these are important for beach trips (again, we do have some to lend out!)

Warm Clothes

- wool sweaters, fleece, long johns, wool socks etc. There is a coin laundry available on site, so don't bring too much!

Gloves

- wool or fleece, also a pair of dishwashing gloves to be used for sorting through the material from the dredges etc.

Flashlight

- new batteries, you will be using these a lot!

Sleeping Bag

- pillow & pillow case provided

Personal items

- toothbrush, towel, shampoo etc.

Daypack

- as waterproof as possible

Pencils, pen, notebook

- for a biological log of all species seen while in Bamfield

Camera and film

Binoculars

- not a necessity but nice to have, waterproof ones are best
